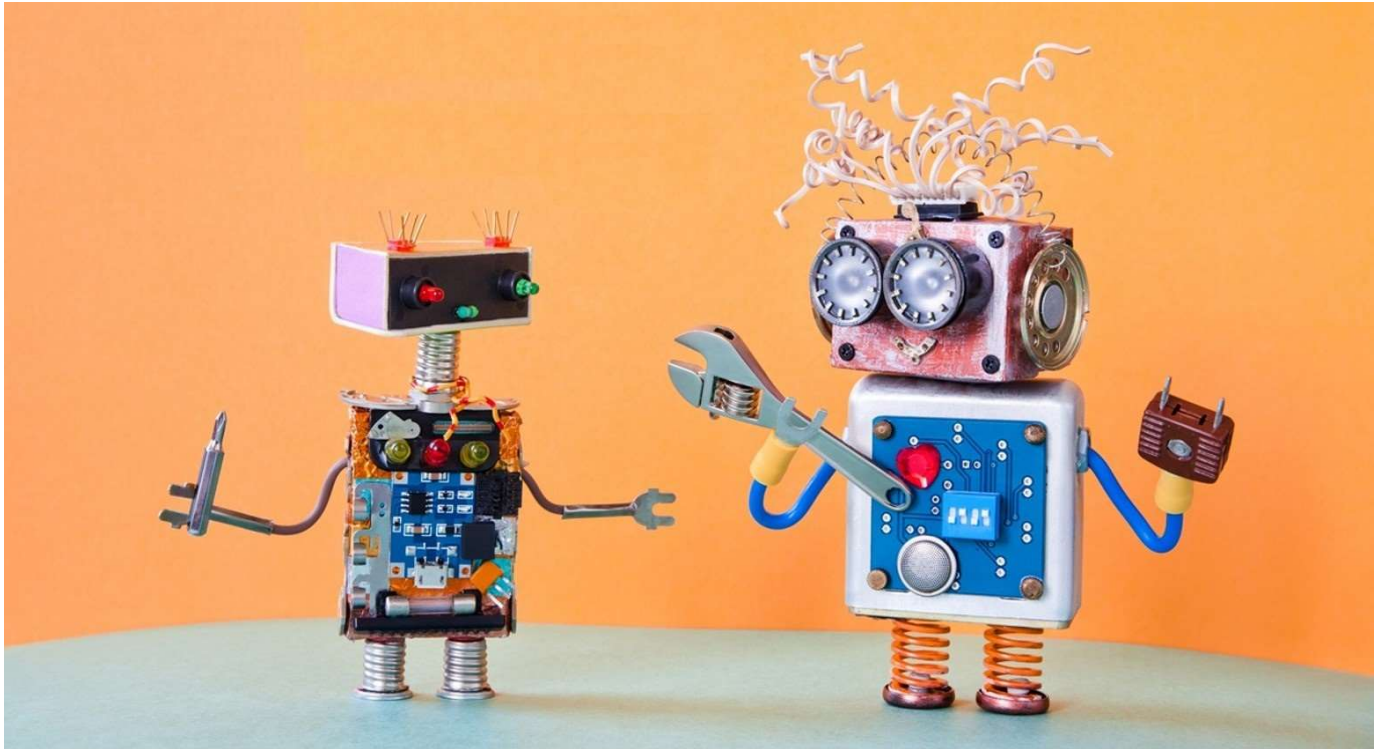

# Liberty Create CH Essentials

(2 days)

## Course Overview

### Course Description

Delegates that attend this two-day course will build on the topics and functionality covered on the Builder Essentials Level 1 course, and follow up Certification, to learn the fundamentals of the Local Government CH core, the Module technology used to build services and how download and share Modules on the Appshare.

### Prerequisites

Attendees of this course must have attended the **Liberty Create Builder Essentials Level 1 course and passed certification** to have a good understanding of the fundamentals of how applications are built in the platform.

### Target Audience

Local Government customers wishing to adopt the CH Framework and utilise Modules to provide services.

### Learning Objectives

- How to download and install the components of the framework
- How to configure the framework
- How to build from scratch in the framework
  - Process
  - Multipage forms
  - Publishing from Host to Central.
- How to download and install a module from the AppShare
- How to modify an installed module.

### Course Structure

This is an instructor-led classroom course for groups of up to a maximum of 8 attendees and involves a combination of presentation, guided exercises and assignments. Over the 2 days, attendees will be introduced to additional capabilities of the Liberty Create platform. By the end of the course attendees will have downloaded and installed the CH Framework, built a module from scratch, and downloaded and installed a Module from the AppShare.
